Mark 11:20-26 Slot machine God – hit the jackpot?!

 Faith <u>NOT</u> presumption – does not mean, "If you pray hard enough God is obligated to answer your prayers, no matter what you ask."

That kind of faith is not faith in God;
 but faith in faith, or faith in feelings.



Faith is linked to the will of God NOT our whims:

- Psalm 37:4 "delight yourself in the Lord"
- Prov 3:5-6 "lean not on your own understanding"
- 1 John 5:14-15 boldness/confidence (according to His will)
- Matt 6:10
 "let your kingdom come...Your will be done"



THE PURPOSE OF PRAYER (& FASTING) IS NOT TO GET MAN'S WILL DONE IN HEAVEN, BUT TO GET GOD'S WILL DONE ON EARTH



Context of Mark 11:12-26 cursing of fig tree & cleansing temple

What has faith God to do with cursing fig trees and moving mountains?

 Firstly, the context is a lesson from Jesus on spiritual failure



• The fig tree is associated with the nation of Israel (Jer. 8:13; Hos. 9:10; Nah. 3:12).

- Like the fig tree Jesus cursed, Israel had "nothing but leaves."
- Israel had failed to be fruitful for God and the religious leaders would not heed his message.
- Christ is still seeking fruit from His people (John 15:16)



- Secondly, the context is a lesson from Jesus on true faith.
- "Have faith in God," = "Constantly be trusting God; live in an attitude of dependence on Him."
- In Jewish imagery, mountain = strong and immovable problem (Zech. 4:7).
- NOT only lesson Jesus ever gave on prayer, not to isolate it from the rest of Scripture.
- Prayer must be in the will of God (1 John 5:14–15)



ANCIENT & MODERN DANGER OF TRIUMPHIALISM

1 Cor 4:8-9

"You think you already have everything you need." You think you are already rich. You have begun to reign in God's kingdom without us! I wish you really were reigning already, for then we would be reigning with you. Instead, I sometimes think God has put us apostles on display, like prisoners of war at the end of a victor's parade, condemned to die. We have become a spectacle to the entire world to people and angels alike."



FAITH IS CRITICAL BUT IT HAS TO DO WITH DEMONSTRATING GOD'S KINGDOM (LET YOUR KINGDOM COME)

Mark 9:29 "This kind".....
 Root out lack of faith/unbelief

• Romans 1:17

"The just shall live by faith"

(Habakkuk 2:4)



- An Old Testament book written by the prophet Habakkuk to the people of Israel around 600 BC.
- Hab 2:4 in the NLT is, "Look at the proud! They trust in themselves, and their lives are crooked. But the righteous will live by their faithfulness to God"
- J. B. PHILLIPS Version Rom 1:17 "For I am not ashamed.....a process begun and continued by their faith."
- MSG Version—"God's way of putting people right shows up in the acts of faith"



FAITH = FAITHFULNESS

• Acts 2:42 "they devoted themselves" Acts 2:47 so God added to the church

Gal 5:23 part of fruit of Holy Spirit



God is looking for the faithfulness that trusts Him despite how we might be feeling or how the circumstances look.

Romans 4:18-20 Abraham, Father of faith
