



1 COR 12 SPIRITUAL GIFTS

- CORE TRUTH 1 Gifts are given to every follower of Jesus. (1 Cor12:7)
- CORE TRUTH 2 Gifts are given to build up the body of Christ. (1 Cor 12:12-20)
- CORE TRUTH 3 Gifts should be used wisely to accomplish God's work. (1 Cor 12:28-30)

COMMITMENT: 1 COR 13:6-7

Isaiah 50:4–11 contains the prophecy of the suffering of the Messiah (v7 "face like flint")

"I offered my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who pulled out my beard; I did not hide my face from mocking and spitting" (Isaiah 50:6; cf. Matthew 26:67; 27:26; Mark 15:19; Luke 22:63).



Luke echoes this resolute image of Christ set on saving His people:

"When the days drew near for him to be taken up, he set his face to go to Jerusalem" (Luke 9:51, ESV).



Staying on track in the Christian life requires setting our faces like flint, to be resolved, committed:

- run the race with our eyes on the prize (1 Corinthians 9:24–27).
- to finish his course (Philippians 3:12–14).
- completing His God-given mission (Acts 20:24)

"But my life is worth nothing to me unless I use it for finishing the work assigned me by the Lord Jesus—the work of telling others the Good News about the wonderful grace of God" Acts 20:24 (NLT).


